



FLIGHTS BETWEEN TORONTO AND MONT-TREMBLANT ARE BACK FOR THE 2021-2022 WINTER SEASON

Mont-Tremblant, November 4th, 2021 – Air service between Toronto and Mont-Tremblant will be reintroduced as of Dec. 17th, in time for the holidays.

Following an agreement with Porter Airlines, the winter schedule will have up to four flights a week between Billy-Bishop City Center Airport and Mont-Tremblant International Airport, from Dec. 17th to March 28th.

Flights were interrupted in March 2020 and there was no air service with airlines since.

Philippe Laudat, Fly Laurentians' President declares: "We are happy that flights are back. This air service alternative is great for our Toronto Area visitors, offering them a quick access to Mont-Tremblant and its winter activities."
